Programs for kids

Cycle City - June 27

Find out about the bicycling craze of the 1890s and cycling's continued popularity today, see how our ancestors enjoyed this form of recreation, make your own set of customized handle bar streamers, and take a virtual trail ride with experienced local guides.

Farm City - July 11

Tour our Farm Life exhibit to learn about generations of farm families and their neighbors, try a series of child-sized farm chores before modernization, meet local farmers to hear stories of their farming adventures, and sample a farm fresh snack.

Tree City - July 18

Examine the history of our region's forests from the lumbering and logging era to now, join representatives of the City of Eau Claire's Green Team for a special presentation, view a charming collection of antique and modern woodcarvings on display, and make a sheet of colorful homemade paper.

Playful City - July 25

Discover how kids played in earlier times, play with a wide assortment of historic toys and games from our hands-on collection, build a replica toy from found objects and recycled materials, and entertain yourself with old-fashioned amusements, both inside and outdoors.

Bird City - August 8

Investigate the important role of birds in our region past and present, learn about the legend of Old Abe the Civil War Eagle, go on a bird watching quest in Carson Park, and design your own decorative bird house to take home.

Music City - August 15

Explore a variety of folk music traditions, enjoy a mini-concert with talented local musicians, meet a Chippewa Valley instrument builder and hear an impromptu tune, and construct a small working folk instrument just for fun.
