## *The Historic Schlegelmilch House*

The house dates from 1871, a year before Eau Claire became a city.

A gunsmith by trade, Herman Schlegelmilch came from Suhl, Germany, to New York in 1853. Two years later he moved to Beaver Dam, Wis., where he met and married Augusta Krueger. They moved to Eau Claire, started a successful hardware store, made their home, and raised five children.



Their daughter Louise remodeled and expanded the house in 1906, and lived there until her death in 1948. Her niece, Agnes Barland McDaniel, gave the house to the Chippewa Valley Museum in 1978. The museum has restored, cared for, and opened the house to the public as a historic site.

The house is filled with period furnishing: oriental rugs, 1906 lighting fixtures, a spinning wheel and sewing gear, an elegant wood pantry, and paintings by regional artist S.O. Lund.

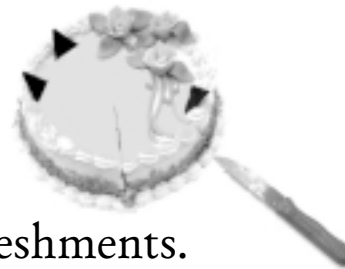
