Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

Fund Development (70%)

- Build corporate sponsorship program
- Maintain donor database
- Become familiar with museum's mission, capital needs, and programs to engage potential donors and sponsors
- Assist in membership development

Special Events (20%)

- Create and coordinate special donor and sponsor stewardship events
- Assist in special fundraising events

Operations/Other (10%)

• Supervise weekend building operations on rotation, as assigned.
