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ABOUT THE TEEN GUIDES PROGRAM:

Teen Guides advance the Chippewa Valley Museum's mission to connect people to our community and inspire curiosity by collecting, preserving, and sharing our region's historical and cultural resources. Program participants share the museum's resources with the community by volunteering in the Ice Cream Parlor, Museum Store, or at the Admissions Desk. Teen Guides also engage with visitors by interpreting the Anderson Log House or the Sunnyview schoolhouse. Finally, Teen Guides play an important role in special programs, including the annual July 4th Family Celebration and Kaleidoscope summer learning programs for younger children.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:

1. Interested students who are 13 through 17 years old may mail or email applications with accompanying essays of interest and recommendation letters by the **application deadline of April 17, 2020.**
2. Accepted teens must **attend one Tuesday orientation: May 5 or May 12, 6:30-8:00pm.**
3. Teen Guides must **attend one three-day training session: June 9, 10, 11 or June 16, 17, 18** from 10:00am-2:30pm with noon dismissal on the third day.
4. After training, Teen Guides must **complete 32 hours of service-learning.** The museum is open seven days a week during the summer. Available shifts are typically three to four hours in length between the hours of 10:00am and 5:00pm (10:00am-8:00pm Tuesdays, 1:00pm-5:00pm Sundays).
5. Teen Guides must have parent/guardian permission and secure their own transportation in order to participate.
